

Job Description: School Age Care One to One Support Worker

Full/Part Time: Part Time. This position is funded by the North Shore Supported Child Development Program and is child specific.

Regular/Temporary: September to June

Hours: 2pm to 6pm; earlier start time on school early dismissal days; extra hours may be offered during school breaks and Pro D days

Wage: Dependent on certification and experience; starting wage is \$18 per hour to a maximum of \$24 per hour, including the BC Wage Enhancement where applicable

- A School Age Care certificate or a 20 Hour Responsible Adult training certificate
- A current, approved emergency first aid certificate (minimum 8-hour course)
- A clear criminal record check

- Training related to guiding challenging behaviour or working with children who need extra support
