Qualifications:

- A minimum of 3 months' experience in a similar environment
- A current safety oriented first aid and CPR certificate (minimum 8-hour course)
- A clear criminal record check

Additional Requirements:

- Must be available to work 35 – 40 hours per week, Monday to Friday, for all 8 weeks starting July 4, 2023
- Must attend two paid mandatory training and preparation sessions on June 24th & 25th 2023
- Must be available to help with summer wrap up/clean up on August 28th & 29th 2023
