

Student Volunteer Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria

This scholarship is available to a graduating secondary school student who:

- has provided outstanding commitment and non-remunerated service to Parkgate programs and activities
- has shown strong scholastic (though not necessarily academic) achievement within their schools
 - Example: A student who has excelled in an apprenticeship program, successfully led a science fair project, or demonstrated exceptional skill in an independent research project or creative endeavour.
- has demonstrated qualities of strong character, citizenship, and leadership
 - Example: A student who organized a community cleanup, led a school club that promoted inclusivity, or consistently volunteered at a local shelter.

Value

One scholarship will be offered in 2025, valued at \$1000.00.

Payment of Funds

Upon receipt of proof of registration in a full-time program of study, leading to a degree or diploma at an accredited Canadian post-secondary institution, Parkgate Society will pay the scholarship funds directly to that institution to go towards the scholarship recipient's tuition fees. Receipt of the scholarship may be deferred for a period of no longer than one academic year.

Application Procedure

Candidates must submit a *Letter of Application* that provides a detailed outline of the volunteer or non-remunerated work they provided to Parkgate programs and/or activities. Optional information within the letter may also include:

- other extra-curricular activities and service within the school and/or communityat-large;
- other non-remunerated work experience;
- financial need (if applicable);
- intended post-secondary program(s) of studies; and
- any additional information that would be helpful to the Student Volunteer Scholarship Committee, including the potential impact of this scholarship for the applicant.





Supporting documentation **must** include:

- at least one (1) reference from an appropriate Parkgate supervisor;
- a letter from a school administrator (or their designate) certifying character, scholastic achievement and school enrollment; and
- an official transcript of grades from the school showing final percentages for all completed grade ten, eleven and twelve courses, as well as interim grades for all courses in progress.

Note: The Letter of Application and all supporting documents will be retained in strict confidence by the Selection Committee.

Application Deadline

The *Letter of Application*, together with all of the supporting documents, must be received on or before **Thursday**, **May 1, 2025**.
